Registration Procedure

- (1) Anyone registering for a Church should bring with them a letter from the Church Administrator authorizing that person to register the church.
- (2) Registration will end promptly at 7:00 p.m.. At that time the door will be locked and no one else will be permitted to register.

Voting Procedure

One Member, One Vote. Membership Cooperatives operate on the principle of One Member, One Vote. The By-Laws of Planters Telephone Cooperative further provide that no member may hold more than one membership in the Cooperative. However, an individual who owns both an incorporated business and a residence in Planters' Service Area could have two votes because there are two persons involved - a corporate entity and a natural person. No one under the age of 18 will be permitted to register under any circumstances.

Start connecting today with Georgia Relay



Georgia Relay is a FREE public service administered by the Georgia Public Service Commission that makes it possible for people who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind or have difficulty speaking to communicate over the telephone. A specially trained Communication Assistant (CA) facilitates the call. All relay calls are confidential and there are no records kept of relay conversations. Relay services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. There's no limit on the length or number of calls you may place or receive.

Anyone may initiate a Georgia Relay call, simply by dialing 7-1-1.

Georgia No Call List

Georgia residential consumers who want to reduce the number of unwanted telemarketing calls from telephone solicitors trying to get you to purchase, rent or invest in property, goods or services are encouraged to register with the free Federal Do Not Call Registry.

Consumers are placed on the Georgia Do Not Call List free of charge simply by registering their phone numbers with the Federal Registry. You may register your phone number with the federal list online at www.donotcall.gov or by calling toll-free, 1-888-382-1222, TTY 1-866-290-4236 from the number you wish to register.

While being on the Do Not Call Registry may significantly reduce the number of unwanted solicitations you receive, it will not prevent you from receiving calls from:

- (1) Businesses that have an established relationship with you. An established relationship exists if you have purchased, leased or rented goods or services from the business within 18 months preceding the call, or if you have submitted an application or made an inquiry to the business within three months preceding the call;
- (2) Recognized charitable or religious organizations; or
- (3) Political pollsters or candidates for public office.

Federal law requires telemarketers to search the Registry every 31 days and synchronize their call lists with the phone numbers that are on the Registry. If you receive telemarketing calls after you have registered your telephone number and it has been in the Registry for 31 days, you can file a complaint at DONOTCALL.GOV or by calling 1-888-382-1222, TTY 1-866-290-4236. You will have to know the company's name or phone number to file a "do not call" complaint.

Customer Proprietary Network Information

Planters Telephone Cooperative is aware of the importance of personal privacy to its members. Planters Telephone Cooperative keeps all account of personal privacy strictly confidential to the fullest extent possible and uses industry-accepted technology to safeguard customer data.

Federal law regulates the use of account information by telecommunications companies. These rules allow us to discuss account information only with the person(s) listed on the account. Also, we must be able to verify that the person accessing your account is in fact you.

If your account is listed only in your name, you may want to consider adding another name, if appropriate.

This also applies to voting at the Annual Meeting. Only one authorized person listed on the account can register and vote. For questions or to make changes to your account, please contact the Planters' business office at (912) 857-4411.
